Safe Work Procedure:
<p>1 Ensure appropriate bar is used</p> <p>2 Inspect for bolt tightness, cracks and defects</p> <p>3 When tightening nuts on the bar, always hold bar nose up</p> <p>4 Clean bar groove and oil hose</p> <p>5 Ensure bar is receiving oil</p> <p>6 Grease roller and sprocket nose</p> <p>7 Remove any burred edges on the bar</p> <p>8 Check bar straightness</p> <p>9 Check for pinched or uneven bar groove</p> <p>10 Reverse bar for uneven wear</p>

If an emergency situation occurs while conducting this task, or there is an equipment malfunction, engage the emergency stop and follow the lock out procedure
