<ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1 Do an inspection of work area before starting any task 2 Make eye contact with all equipment operators to ensure they see you 3 Stay alert and periodically look at surroundings to ensure safety 4 Request assistance to move all heavy or awkward objects 5 Practice good housekeeping

If an emergency situation occurs while conducting this task, or there is an equipment malfunction, engage the emergency stop and follow the lock out procedure
