Safe Work Procedure:
<ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1 Remove applicable extinguisher from hanger 2 Carry extinguisher in upright position to fire 3 Pull pin of extinguisher, hold hose or horn in one hand 4 Pull the trigger, aiming at base of fire, squeeze the handle and sweeping motion 5 Report use of extinguisher 6 Take extinguisher out of service and have it re-charged

If an emergency situation occurs while conducting this task, or there is an equipment malfunction, engage the emergency stop and follow the lock out procedure
