<b>Safe Work Procedure:</b>
<p>1 Receive the ticket from the truck driver</p> <p>2 Apply water to the work area if it becomes dusty</p> <p>3 Make sure that you are visible to all truck drivers and equipment operators</p> <p>4 Riding on the running board , boxes or buckets is prohibited</p> <p>5 Measure the dump distances</p> <p>6 The checker should stand at the rear and to one side of the trailer while dumping. Make sure you have eye contact with the truck driver</p> <p>7 Make sure that the trucks are on level ground and kept in straight alignment</p>

***If an emergency situation occurs while conducting this task, or there is an equipment malfunction, engage the emergency stop and follow the lock out procedure***
