

# SAFE JOB PROCEDURE

**Job Description:** Setting up Safety Railings

**Hazards Present:** Fall from heights, Impact injuries from fall

**PPE Required:** Full Body Harness, safety line, Lanyard at all times when setting up railings at the edge

**Note:** Operators of equipment must be trained and deemed competent, must demonstrate operational competency and/or have received approval from their immediate supervisor. Operators must wear the proper PPE as required and be familiar with the location of the use of a fire extinguisher.

## SAFE JOB PROCEDURE

### 1. Setting-up of safety railings;

- ✓ Make sure all components of the safety railing system have been inspected and are in working condition prior to being set up.
- ✓ Make sure that there is a sufficient amount of railing to barricade the work area.
- ✓ Ensure safety railings are installed securely to the roof edge.
- ✓ There must be a safety railing on each side of the tar line to the roof from the kettle

### 2. Check roof for openings;

- ✓ Deck openings present a fall hazard either by tripping over them or falling through
- ✓ Never begin any work on the roof until the openings are covered or barricaded
- ✓ When laying roof membrane mark all roof openings clearly
