<p>Safe Work Procedure:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Ensure that work area is clean 2. Inspect saw for defects before you begin. If found defective, remove saw with lock out tag out. 3. Before plugging in tool, check that the trigger lock is off. 4. Be aware of the location and setting of the switch "lock on" button 5. Hold tool by insulated gripping surfaces. 6. Before cutting turn saw "on" and allow the blade to come to full speed. 7. Ensure that all adjusting screws and the blade holder are tight before making a cut 8. Keep hands away from cutting area. Do not reach under the material being cut 9. Secure material before cutting. 10. Never use dull or damaged blades 11. Ensure the saw is de energized and unplugged then clean dust.
