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| <ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>1 Know the location of nearest emergency wash station</li> <li>2 Use oil carefully with funnel</li> <li>3 Only use what is needed</li> <li>4 Clean up any spills immediately</li> <li>5 If skin comes in contact, wash immediately</li> <li>6 When finished with the oil, store in proper storage unit</li> </ol> |
