Safe Work Procedure:
<ol style="list-style-type: none">1 It is the responsibility of the employee to supply steel toed work boots that cover the ankle bone and gives support to the ankle as per CSA Standards2 It is the responsibility of the employee to wear these steel toed boots each and every day3 All footwear is to be kept tied as to not pose a tripping hazard4 A requirement for specialized footwear as dictated by the hazards will be supplied by the employer

If an emergency situation occurs while conducting this task, or there is an equipment malfunction, engage the emergency stop and follow the lock out procedure
