Safe Work Procedure:
<ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>1 Do pre-trip inspection on machine and start using Cold Start Procedure</li> <li>2 Check back up alarm and all gauges</li> <li>3 Turn on beacon light</li> <li>4 Turn vibrator on only at area to be packed, and if machine starts slipping turn vibrator off</li> <li>5 Use a spotter in tight areas</li> <li>6 Park on level ground and set brake</li> <li>7 Turn off using hot engine method</li> </ol>

***If an emergency situation occurs while conducting this task, or there is an equipment malfunction, engage the emergency stop and follow the lock out procedure***
