Safe Work Procedures
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> *Ensure Boomtruck safety schedule is being updated (As per daily check-ups etc) *Ensure path for Boomtruck remains clear of debris *Roadway to be as level as conditions allow *Have spotter in place when working in close contact with buildings or personnel *Ensure spotter and operator or any personnel in area are wearing high visibility clothing
