Safe Work Procedures
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> *Ensure Trusses are properly braced *Use caution when loading OSB onto deck *Ensure guardrail system is properly installed *Ensure all sawdust and debris is cleared so as to no create extra tripping hazards *If any ladders used, ensure they are tied off and secure *Ensure operator of boomtruck and roof top worker are using proper boomtruck hand signals
