<ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1 Do pre-trip inspection on machine and start using Cold Start Procedure 2 Check back up alarm, all gauges, hydraulics 3 When proceeding to the work location, check the brakes 4 Tarp load 5 Make use of spotter when backing and driving in tight areas 6 Park on secure, level ground 7 Set parking brake

If an emergency situation occurs while conducting this task, or there is an equipment malfunction, engage the emergency stop and follow the lock out procedure
