Safe Work Procedure:
<p>1 Be aware of UV warnings</p> <p>2 Wear long sleeved loose fitting clothing to ensure no exposed skin</p> <p>3 Apply sunscreen with minimum SPF 15 liberally to all exposed skin at least 15 minutes before sun exposure</p> <p>4 Wear proper sunglasses that allow less than 1% UVB radiation</p> <p>5 Drink plenty of liquids (not alcohol)</p> <p>6 If sun burn occurs, make sure it is covered as to not get burned further</p> <p>7 Seek shelter from the sun if possible</p>

If an emergency situation occurs while conducting this task, or there is an equipment malfunction, engage the emergency stop and follow the lock out procedure
