Safe Work Procedure:
<ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>1 Park truck and trailer on level ground and set parking brakes.</li> <li>2 Exit vehicle using three point contact</li> <li>3 Set ramps</li> <li>4 Remove chains/binders from machine and unplug exhaust</li> <li>5 Mount trailer using caution and enter machine using 3 point contact method</li> <li>6 Release brake and raise bucket or attachments just above the deck so as to not flip backwards</li> <li>7 Slowly back off of the trailer and park in secure level area</li> <li>8 Load ramps onto the trailer</li> </ol>

***If an emergency situation occurs while conducting this task, or there is an equipment malfunction, engage the emergency stop and follow the lock out procedure***
