<p style="text-align: center; font-weight: bold;">Safe Work Procedure:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1 Park truck and trailer on level ground and set brake 2 Exit cab using three point contact 3 Remove chains from load 4 Set up ramps 5 Mount trailer using three point contact 6 Mount cab of loader using three point contact 7 Release brake and raise bucket or attachment 6" above the deck 8 Back up slowly and cautiously until loader is on the ground

If an emergency situation occurs while conducting this task, or there is an equipment malfunction, engage the emergency stop and follow the lock out procedure
