<ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>1 Park vehicle /machine on level ground free of debris</li> <li>2 Lock out machine/vehicle</li> <li>3 Ensure all tools are on hand</li> <li>4 Hoist vehicle using proper method</li> <li>5 Place supports such as :                             <ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>A. Vehicle Support Stands</li> <li>B. Wood Fabricated Stands</li> <li>C. Automotive Hoists</li> </ol> </li> <li>6 Cautiously proceed under the vehicle using a creeper if applicable</li> <li>7 Perform work</li> <li>8 Clean up area when finished</li> <li>9 Remove supports and lower vehicle/machine</li> </ol>

***If an emergency situation occurs while conducting this task, or there is an equipment malfunction, engage the emergency stop and follow the lock out procedure***
