Steps	Sequence of Steps	Potential Accidents or Hazards	Recommended Safe Job Procedure
1	Measurement/layout of Fence – Level ground.	General construction hazards.	Use appropriate caution on site.
2	Transport fencing equipment to area.	Fence pieces may fall off equipment or be dropped. Overexertion by labourers.	Utilize caution tape and straps when transporting and get assistance with heavy fence pieces.
3	Erection of fence.	Fence pieces may be erected in an unstable fashion and fall, causing injury or damage.	Erect fence carefully using anchors, connectors and fence standards according to manufacturer's specifications. Check ground level and fence thoroughly when complete.
4	Placement of caution signs	Signage illegible – unauthorized people coming on site without PPE or caution.	Laminate all signs and use large font and regular placement.
