W210 36(1) Where a safety and health officer is of the opinion that any activities which are being, or are about to be, carried on in a workplace, involve or are likely to involve an imminent risk of serious physical health or injury, or where a contravention specified in an improvement order was not remedied and warning was given in accordance with subsection 26(2), the officer may issue an order (hereinafter called a "STOP WORK ORDER") providing for any one or more of the following matters;

- (a) The cessation of those activities.
- (b) That all or part of the workplace be vacated.
- (c) That no resumption of those activities be permitted by the employer.

PURSUANT TO SECTION 36(1), YOU ARE HEREBY ORDERED TO:

Cease all work at heights

THIS STOP WORK ORDER IS ISSUED BECAUSE:

A system for fall protection is not available at this workplace.

W210 36(6) Workers must be paid

While a stop work order is in effect,

- (a) any worker who is directly affected by the order is entitled to the same wages and benefits that he or she would have received had the stop work order not been issued; and
- (b) the employer may re-assign the worker to alternate work.

36(7) If alternate work not available

If the employer provides satisfactory evidence to the director that alternate work is not available, the director may order that clause 6(a) does not apply for any period that the director specifies in

the order, but until the director makes an order the employer is required to provide a worker with all wages and benefits under that clause.
