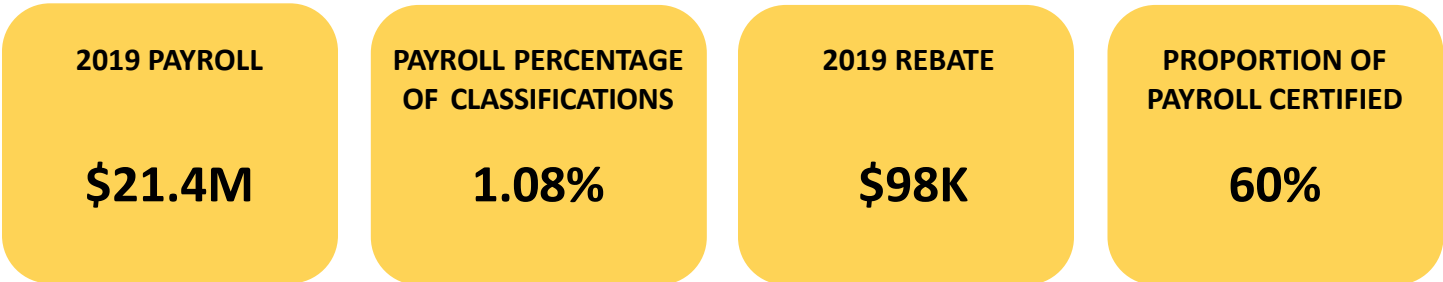

40104 INSTALLING METAL PRODUCTS

Installing Metal Products is one of the smaller Industry Classifications at just over 1% of total CSAM payroll. Payroll in this classification remained relatively flat in 2019 compared to 2018.

Currently, the Classification is slotted into the 300% Risk Category. It saw a significant increase in certification percentage going from 49% to 59% in 2019.

Severe Injuries dropped from 8 in 2018, to 4 in 2019. In 2019, of the 4 Severe Injuries, 75% (3) occurred in a work environment that was NOT safety certified.

Please refer to the cover page to identify the top 3 drivers of Severe Injuries in the classification. Given that Severe Injuries amount to more than 80% of claims costs, they should continue to be the primary focus of any initiatives going forward.
