This classification has seen a 10% increase in payroll growth from 2018 to 2019. Despite this growth, it dropped from being the 8th largest classification to the 9th largest with payroll of approximately \$51M in payroll.

This classification currently resides in the 200% Risk Category, however, has recently shown signs of claims costs more reflective of the 250% Risk Category. Approximately 40% of the payroll is COR® Certified.

Severe Injuries dropped dramatically in 2019 from 17 the previous year to 10, of which, 40% (4) occurred in a work environment that was NOT safety certified.

Please refer to the cover page to identify the top 3 drivers of Severe Injuries. Given that Severe Injuries amount to more than 80% of claims costs, they should continue to be a primary focus of any initiatives going forward.
