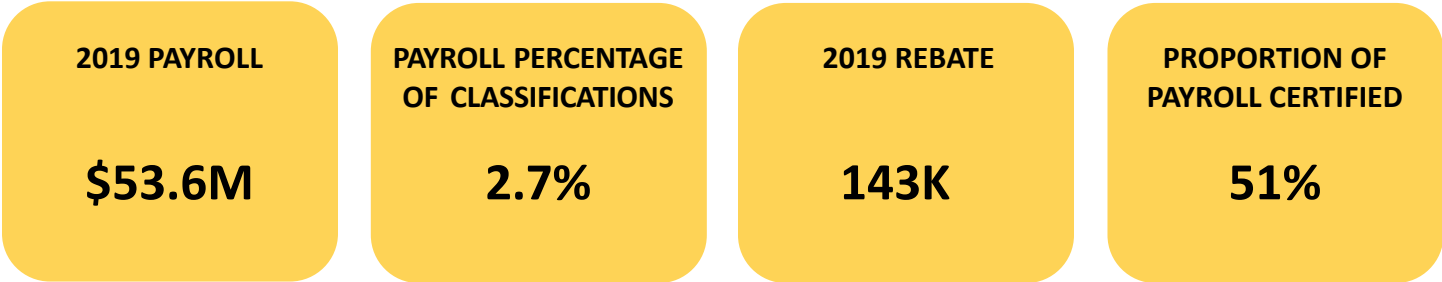

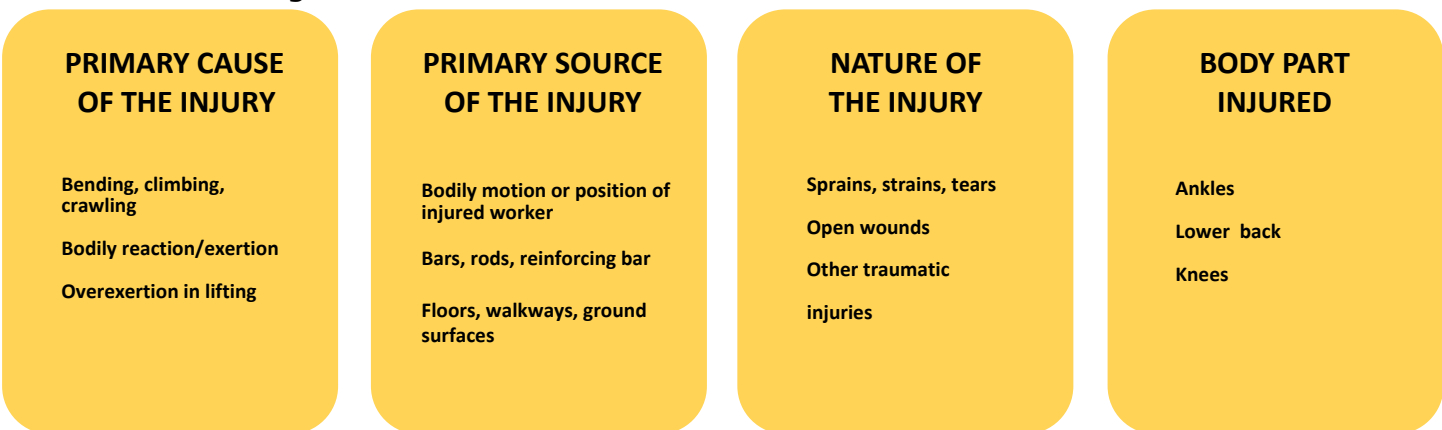

## 40110 CONCRETE WORK

Concrete Work is the 7th largest of the 18 classifications of levied employers assigned to CSAM. The classification saw approximately 11% payroll growth comparing the years 2018 to 2019.

Just over 50% of the reported payroll is COR® Certified. The classification remains in the 300% Risk Category and risk currently is not trending in either direction.

The classification represents just under 3% of all reported payroll and in comparison is responsible for just over 3% of all Severe Injuries within the CSAM environment. In 2019, there was a total of 12 Severe Injuries of which 33% (4) happened within a work environment that was NOT safety certified.

Please refer to the cover page to identify the top 3 drivers of Severe Injuries in the Concrete Industry in 2019. Given that Severe Injuries amount to more than 80% of claims costs they should continue to be the primary focus of any initiatives going forward.
