40203 ELECTRICAL CONTRACTING

This Classification is the 4th largest within the CSAM group of levied classifications. It also saw almost 12% of growth of payroll from 2018 to 2019.

Electrical Contracting remains solidly in the 125% Risk Category and is close to 70% COR[®] Certified. This classification has the highest ratio of premium refund from rebate at approximately 13%.

Electrical Contracting's Severe Injury ratio is quite low compared to the other large classifications. In 2018, there were a total of 18 Severe Injuries and despite 12% payroll growth in 2019, Severe injuries dropped to 15. Although more of the Severe Injuries took place within the certified environment 2019=10 COR[®]/5 non-COR[®], it is less than the proportional certification percentage of almost 70%.

Please refer to the cover page to identify the top (3) drivers of Severe Injuries in the Electrical Contracting Industry. Given that Severe Injuries amount to more than 80% of claims costs they should continue to be the primary focus of any initiatives going forward.
