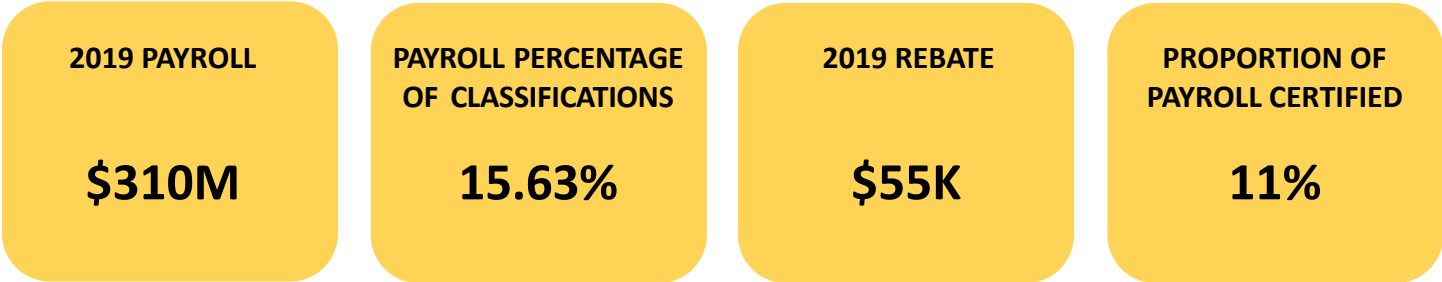

40903 TOWER & ENERGY CONSTRUCTION

In 2018, Tower and Energy was the 2nd largest of the (18) CSAM levied classifications. In 2019, its payroll dropped by (14%) from \$362.1M to \$310.5M. As a result it has dropped to the 3rd largest classification.

Despite the classifications size, it has the smallest amount of safety certified payroll at 11.4%. This probably speaks to the nature of the work within the classification. A good portion of the work is Manitoba Hydro project work completed by out of province contractors or companies that have a limited life line as they have only been established for the purposes of the project.

In 2018, the classification was responsible for (77) Severe Injuries. In 2019, this number dropped to (40) or a (48%) decrease. So, even after factoring in the (14%) drop in payroll this change is significant. It is assumed that the larger projects may have moved into a less risky phase of work to account for this change.

This classification currently resides in the 200% Risk Category although it is trending towards the 250% Risk Category.
