40904 RAILWAY CONSTRUCTION

This Classification is very specific to work contracted to railway maintenance and therefore is one of the smaller classifications. It currently ranks 15th in size with less than 1% of CSAM payroll. Payroll grew by approximately 15% from 2018-2019.

The Classification currently resides in the 75% Risk Category and has shown prior trends of claims costs more reflective of the 60% risk category.

Currently, about 70% of the Classification is COR[®] Certified. There appears to be less than 100 employers within the Industry Classification.

Over the past 2 years this group of employers has had 3 Severe Injuries each year with most recently 67% (2) happening in a work environment that was NOT safety certified. In 2019 there were a total of 8 time loss injuries.

Please refer to the cover page to identify top drivers of injury, however, given the low numbers they are not statistically valid.
