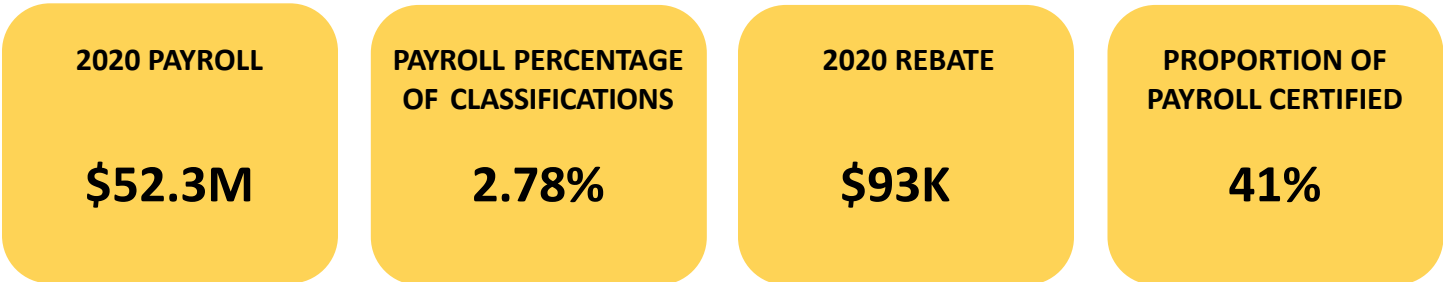

## 40105 PAINTING AND DECORATING

This classification saw a 3% increase in Actual Payroll growth in 2020 despite the pandemic. It is currently the 9th largest classification with Actual Payroll of \$52.3M.

The Classification currently resides in the 200% Risk Category, however, continues to trend towards the 250% Risk Category due to higher claims costs.

There has been some stability in claims more recently with Severe Injuries increasing from (10) to (11) when comparing 2019 to 2020 and Time Loss Injuries reducing from (39) to (32). Approximately 41% of the payroll is certified and of the (11) Severe Injuries, (8) of them occurred in a non-certified work environment.

Please refer to the cover page to identify the top (3) drivers of Severe Injuries. Our focus continues to remain on Severe Injuries given they account for over 80% of claims costs and their overall cost to human life.
