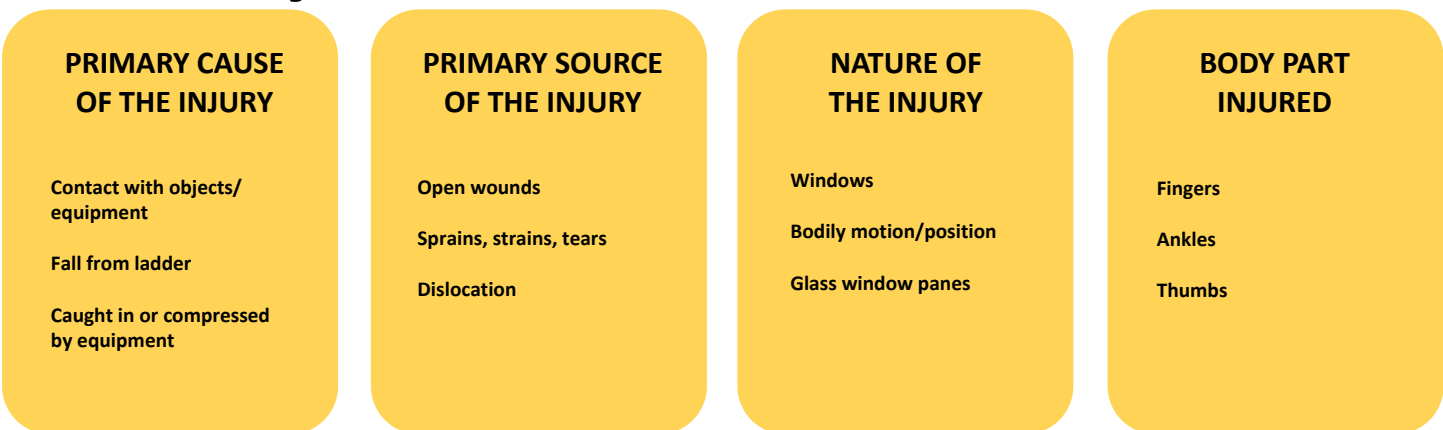
TIMELOSS INJURIES

40109 INSTALLING DOORS AND WINDOWS

This Classification saw significant payroll growth in 2020, previously captured in 2019 at \$17.9M and now reported at \$19.4M.

Claims costs remain low within the classification more reflective of the 250% Risk Category. While it remains in the 300% Risk Category, if the current trend continues it can anticipate moving to the 250% category in the next year or two.

Currently 30% of the payroll is safety certified. It saw a significant drop in Severe Injuries in 2020, (6) down from (11) the previous year. All (6) Severe Injuries occurred in a non-certified work environment.

Please refer to the cover page to identify the top (3) drivers of Severe Injuries. This data is based on a (5) year history of claims.
