40115 LANDSCAPING

This classification continues to grow increasing from 2019 Actual Payroll of approximately \$52M to \$58M in 2020 or 12% growth.

As previously reported, Landscaping currently resides in the 125% Risk Category, however, over the past (4) years it has shown costs more reflective of the 150% Risk Category. It will be moved to the new Risk Category for 2022 Rate Setting. The vast majority of employers within the classification can anticipate a rate increase next year.

The industry continues to show increases in Severe Injuries (15) in 2019, compared to (23) in 2020 or an approximate 53% increase. Of the (23) Severe Injuries, (19) occurred in a non safety certified work environment. About 31% of the industry payroll is safety certified.

Please refer to the cover page to identify the top (3) drivers of Severe Injuries. This data is based on a (5) year history of claims.
