40602 INSTALLING ELEVATORS

This Classification is very small, ranked 17th amongst the CSAM Classifications. It represents less than 1% of overall payroll.

It has the distinction of having the lowest Risk Category at 60% amongst all construction Classifications. There is approximately 25 active employers assigned to the Classification, however, given that over 95% of the Classification is safety certified, this would suggest that there are perhaps a few employers doing the vast majority of work within this industry.

The classification is 95% safety certified and remains in the 60% Risk Category

There is basically no reference point for drivers of claim incidents within the industry.

The classification paid approximately \$94k in premium and received \$24k in return through the Rebate process.
