## 40904 RAILWAY CONSTRUCTION

This Classification is very specific to work contracted to railway maintenance and therefor is one of the smaller classifications. It currently ranks 16th in size with less than 1% of CSAM payroll. Payroll has remained relatively flat when comparing 2019 with 2020 at approximately \$19M.

The Classification currently resides in the 75% Risk Category and its claims cost history suggests its in the appropriate risk category. Approximately 62% of the payroll is safety certified.

In 2020, the Industry did not have a Severe Injury. Time Loss Injuries dropped from (9) in 2019 to (2) in 2020 or a 78% reduction.
