## 50311 AUDIO VISUAL SERVICES

This classification has remained relatively stable when comparing 2019 Actual Payroll of \$53.4M to 2020 payroll of \$54.4M.

Approximately 30% of this payroll is safety certified. The industry currently resides in the 25% Risk Category, however, has shown a trend over the past (4) years of claims costs more consistent with the 33% Risk Category. In all likelihood it will be moved to the new Risk Category for rate setting in 2022 resulting in the majority of employers experiencing a rate increase.

Severe Injuries increased by (1) in 2020 to (4). Time Loss Injuries dropped by 25% from (24) in 2019 to (18) in 2020.

Please refer to the cover page to view the accumulated injury data. We normally track Severe Injuries over a (5) year history, however, due to very low numbers we have referenced Time Loss Injury data instead to provide better insight into the industry.
