70605 YARD MAINTENANCE AND PEST CONTROL

This classification is relatively small representing 1.1% of Actual Payroll of all assigned classifications. It has 2020 Actual Payroll of approximately \$29.7M up from \$27.8M the year before.

Approximately 3% of this payroll is certified and the classification comfortably sits in the 125% Risk Category.

In 2020, there was a significant spike in Severe Injuries from (2) in 2019 to (11) in 2020. Time Loss Injuries remained relatively flat at (28) compared to the previous year of (26).
