This classification is one of the smaller classifications, however, saw Actual Payroll growth of close to 15% in 2021 with Actual Payroll now at \$14.9M.

It has less than 50 employers and approximately 35% of the above payroll amount is safety certified.

In 2021, there was one reported Severe Injury in a non certified work environment.

The Classification sits comfortably in the 40% Risk Category.
