This Classification saw modest payroll growth in 2021. It also saw its Severe Injury ratio return to a more common range given its spike in 2020 to 16. In 2021, the Classification had 8 Severe Injuries and 26 Time Loss Injuries. Of the 8 Severe Injuries (4) took place in a safety certified work environment.

This classification recently incurred a Rate Risk Category increase to 150% and if current claims costs trends continue it can anticipate a further increase within a couple of years. The increase will effect the vast majority of employers within the classification.
