This classification has seen ongoing growth with an increase in payroll to \$58.7M up 12% from 2020. Despite this growth, Severe Injuries dropped from 10 in 2020, to 6 in 2021 of which 1 occurred in a safety certified work environment. Time Loss injuries remain flat at 32 claims in each of the past 2 years.

This classification currently resides in the 200% Risk Category, however, has been showing signs of claims costs more reflective of the 250% Risk Category suggesting that the majority of the approximate 400 employers will see an increase in rates. 41% of the payroll is safety certified.
