Drywall & Stucco Contracting saw fairly significant payroll growth in 2021 up 10% from 2020 or \$62M to 68.6M

50% of reported payroll within the classification is COR® certified. This industry classification remains in the 300% Risk Category and currently is not trending in either direction.

The classification saw a slight increase in Severe Injuries from 13 in 2020 to 17 in 2021. Of the 17, (11) took place in a safety certified work environment. The classification represents less than 3% of the assigned payroll to CSAM, yet, is responsible for almost 5% of Severe Injuries. This speaks to the high Risk Category.
