Concrete Work has remained relatively stable when comparing 2020 to 2021. Actual Payroll increased \$700k to \$59.7M. Approximately 52% of this payroll is safety certified.

The classification remains in the 300% Risk Category and saw a dramatic drop in Severe Injuries from (21) in 2020 to (13) in 2021. (8) of the (13) took place in a safety certified work environment.
