Electrical Contracting remains in the 125% Risk Category and the payroll is 70% COR® certified.

Electrical Contracting has shown a recent increase in Severe Injuries from (19) in 2020 to (30) in 2021 of which (21) of these happened in a safety certified work environment. This is a fairly significant increase despite the approximate 10% growth in payroll.
