#### **40602 INSTALLING ELEVATORS**

This Classification is very small representing less than 1% of Actual Payroll. All metrics have remained relatively stable in 2021.

The classification experienced one Severe Injury in 2021 in a non-certified worksite. This is the first Severe Injury in the past couple of years. When referring to drivers of claims incidents the data is very limited and we have focused on Time Loss Injuries incurred over the past 5 years.

The Classification is comfortably in the 60% Risk Category and 95% of the approximate \$14.6M payroll is safety certified. There are 15 employers within the classification.
