This Classification is very specific to work contracted to railway maintenance and therefor is one of the smaller classifications and represents less than 1% of overall payroll. Actual Payroll dropped in 2021 to \$16.2M from \$19M.

The Classification currently resides in the 75% Risk Category and has shown prior trends of claims costs more reflective of the 60% risk category.

Currently, about 70% of the Classification is COR® Certified and there are less than 30 employers.

In 2021 they were responsible for (1) Severe Injury and (2) Time Loss claims. All claims occurred in a non certified work environment.

We refer you to the cover page to identify top drivers of injury, however, given the low numbers they are not statistically valid.
