
#### **50504 TELECOMMUNICATIONS**

This classification is amongst the largest industries assigned to CSAM. It represents approximately 9% of all Actual Payroll at \$233.1M in 2020 down about 4.6% from the previous year.

It currently resides in a very low Risk Category of 15% and the industry does not participate in the safety certificate program as it does not have any of its (56) employers safety certified. Over the past (4) years the industry has shown claims costs more consistent with the 20% Risk Category and in all likelihood will be moved to this Risk Category in the 2022 Rate Setting year. This will result in the majority of the employers receiving a rate increase.

In 2020, the Industry experienced (7) Severe Injuries up from (5) the previous year and (49) Time Loss Injuries up from (32) in 2019.
