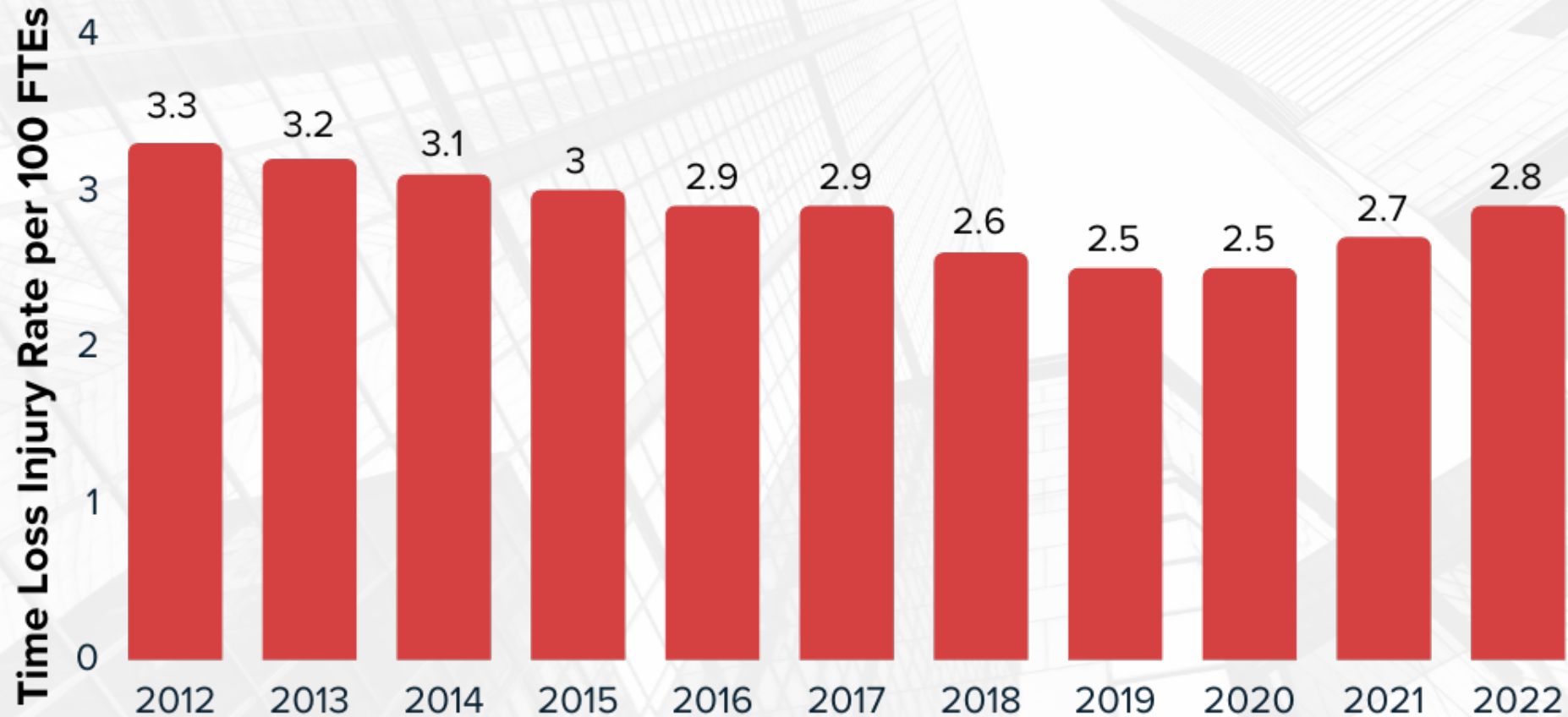

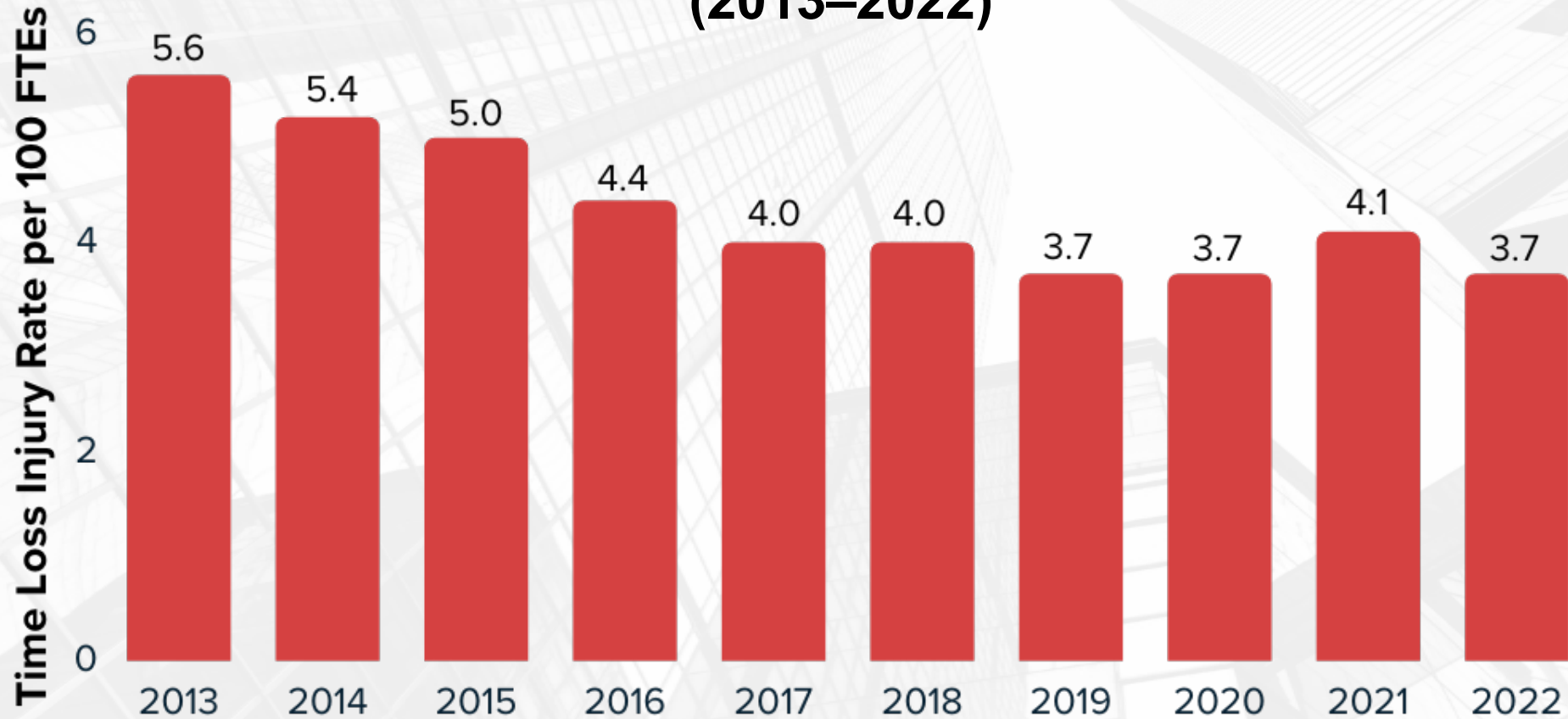
2022 Injury & Illness Report

Manitoba Time Loss Injury Rate (2012–2022)

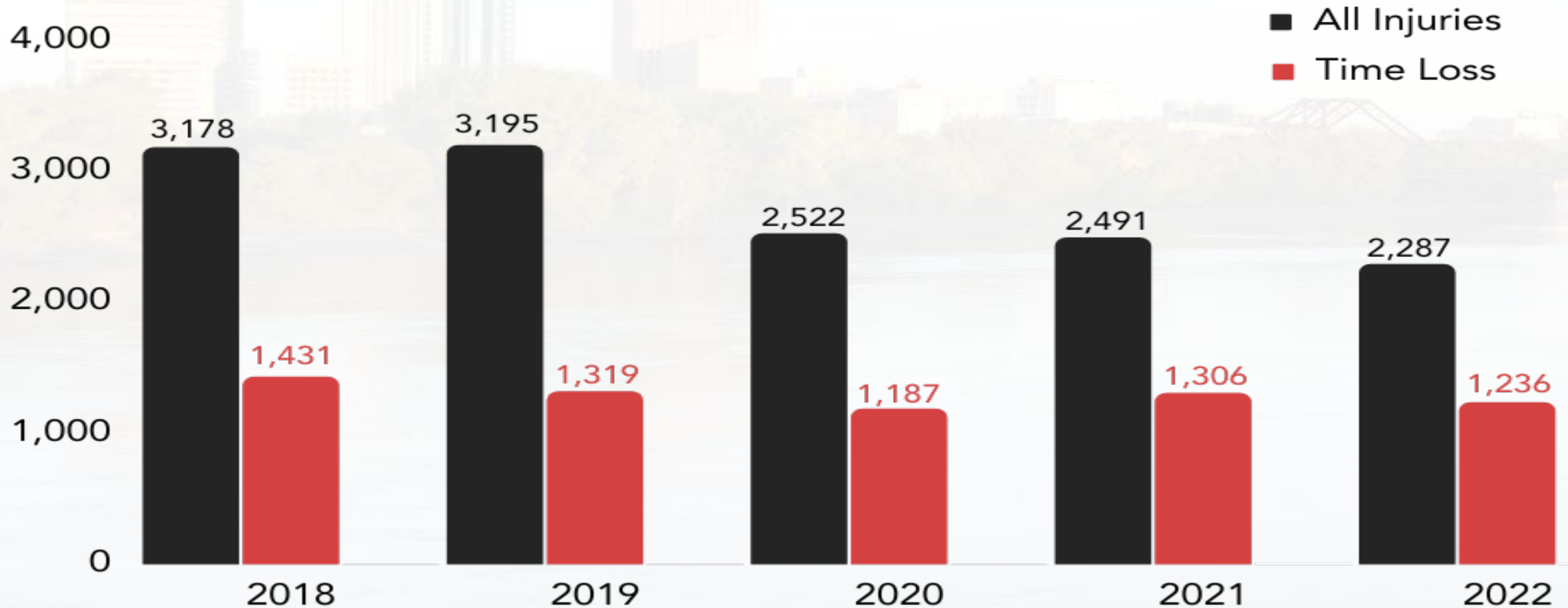

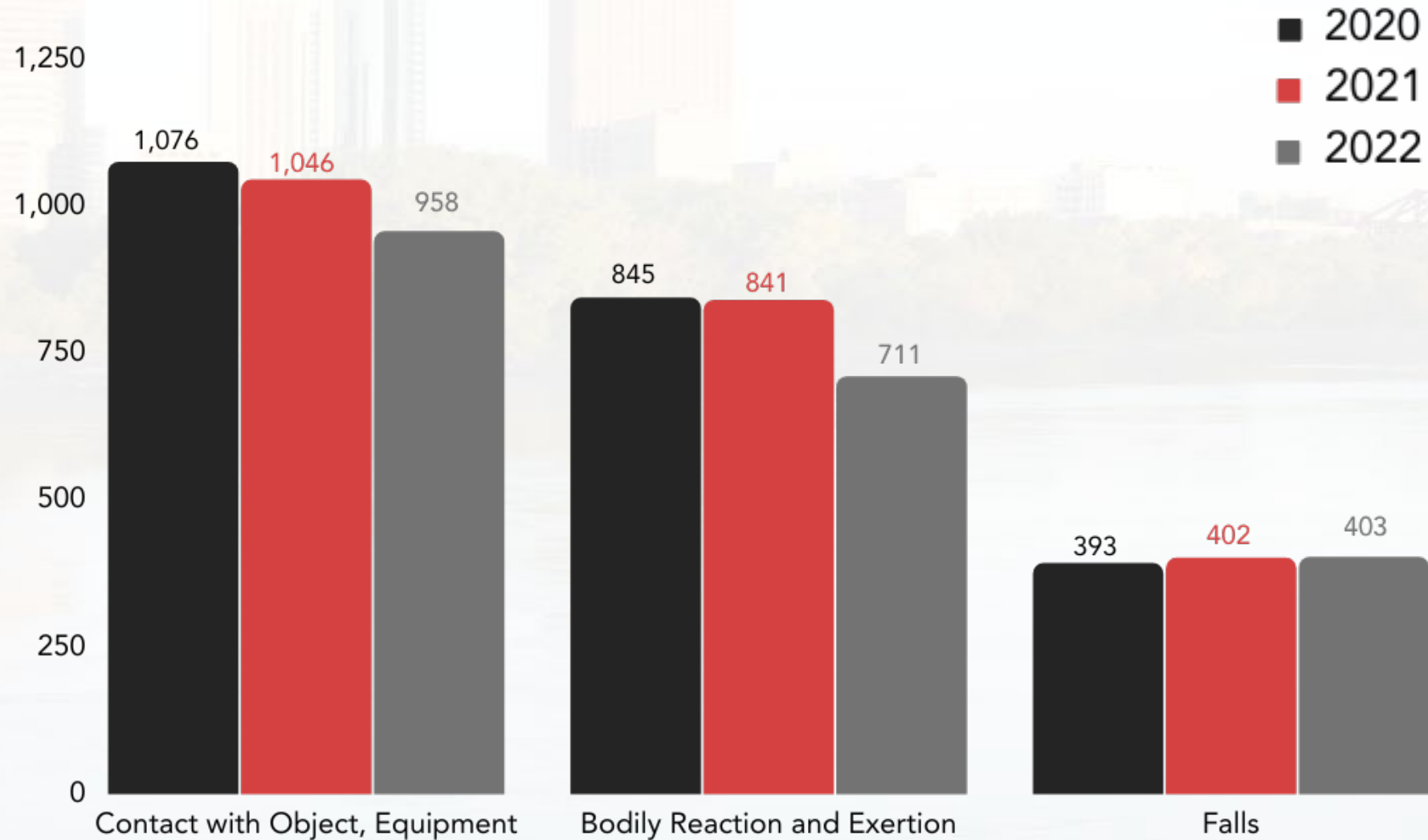
Building Construction Time Loss Injury Rate (2013–2022)



Building Construction: Time Loss



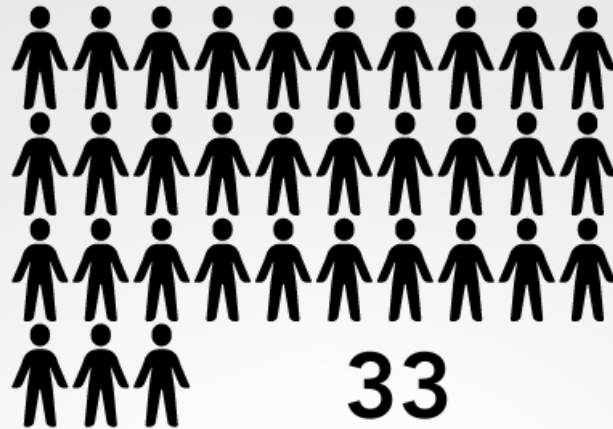
Building Construction: Top 3 Injury/Illness Events



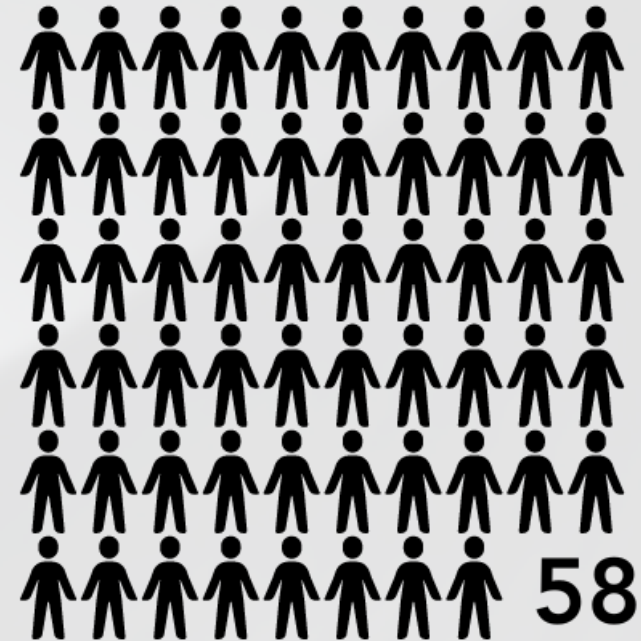
Fatalities by Occupation

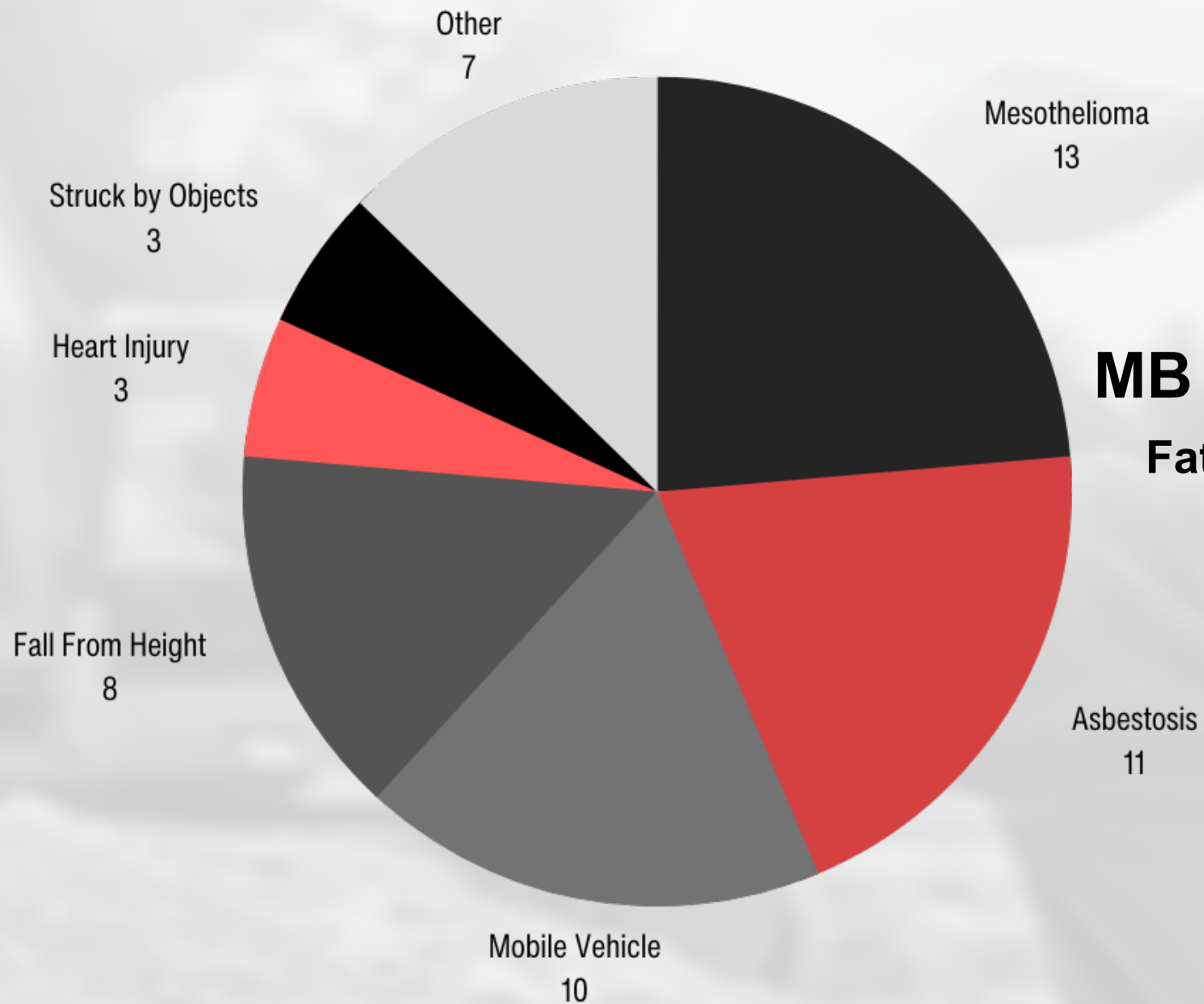

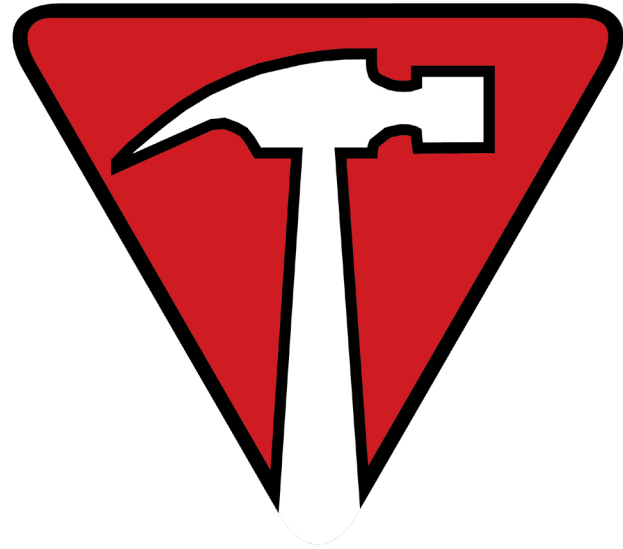

Enforcement Strategy 2023-24

- Repeat or willful non-compliance
- Fail to Report Serious Incidents
- Fail to notify- excavations
- High Risk Industries- higher than average LTI
- High Risk Workplaces- perform poorly against peers
- workplaces associated with high risk hazardous substances or health hazards- asbestos, haz chemicals, MSI, hearing conservation

High Risk Industries:

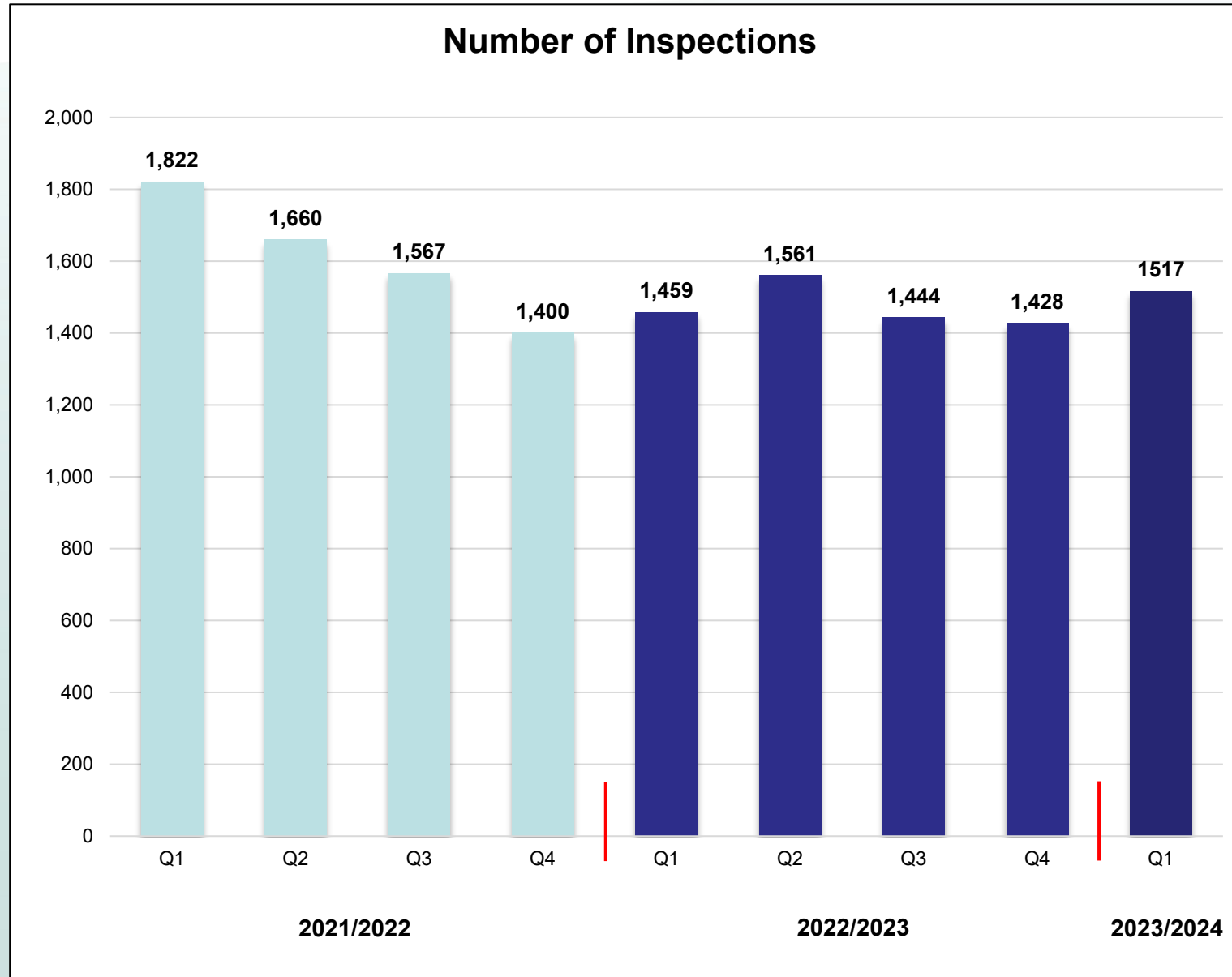
Enhanced data sharing with WCB has allowed WSH to identify and focus on the following high priority industry classifications.

While all sectors were assessed, the following industry classifications have significantly higher than average number of Lost Time Injuries per 100 workers. Inspections will be carried out to ensure appropriate systems and controls are in place to adequately manage priority hazards:

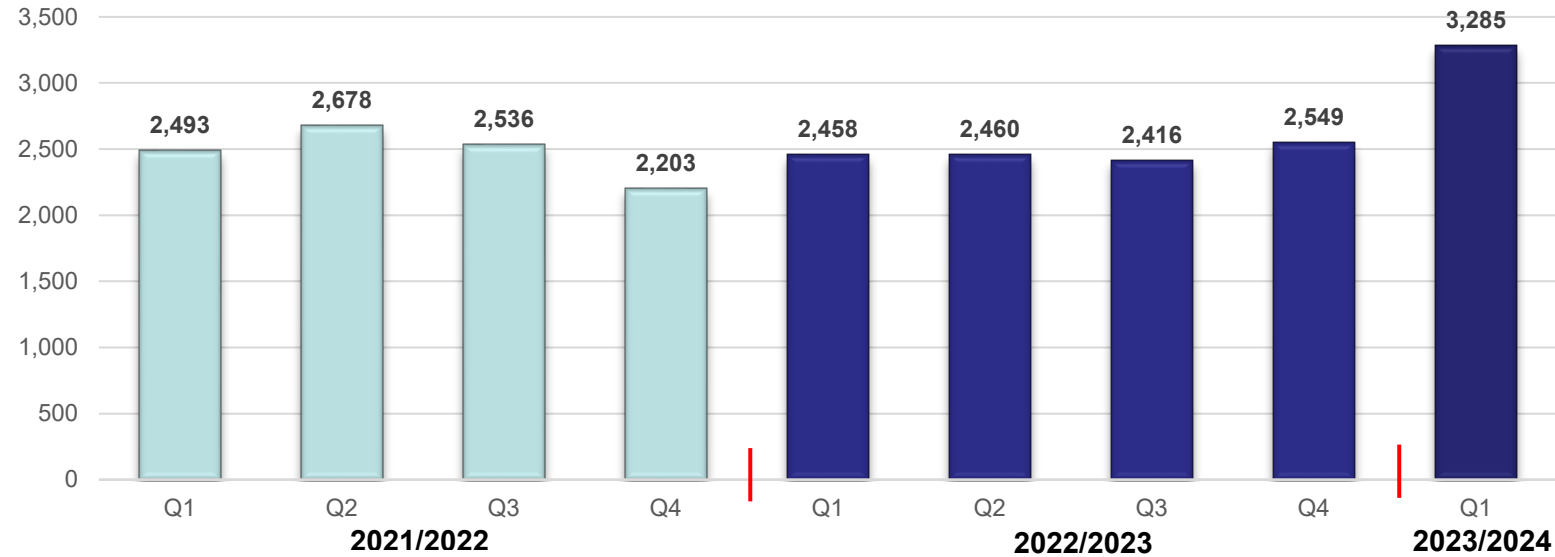

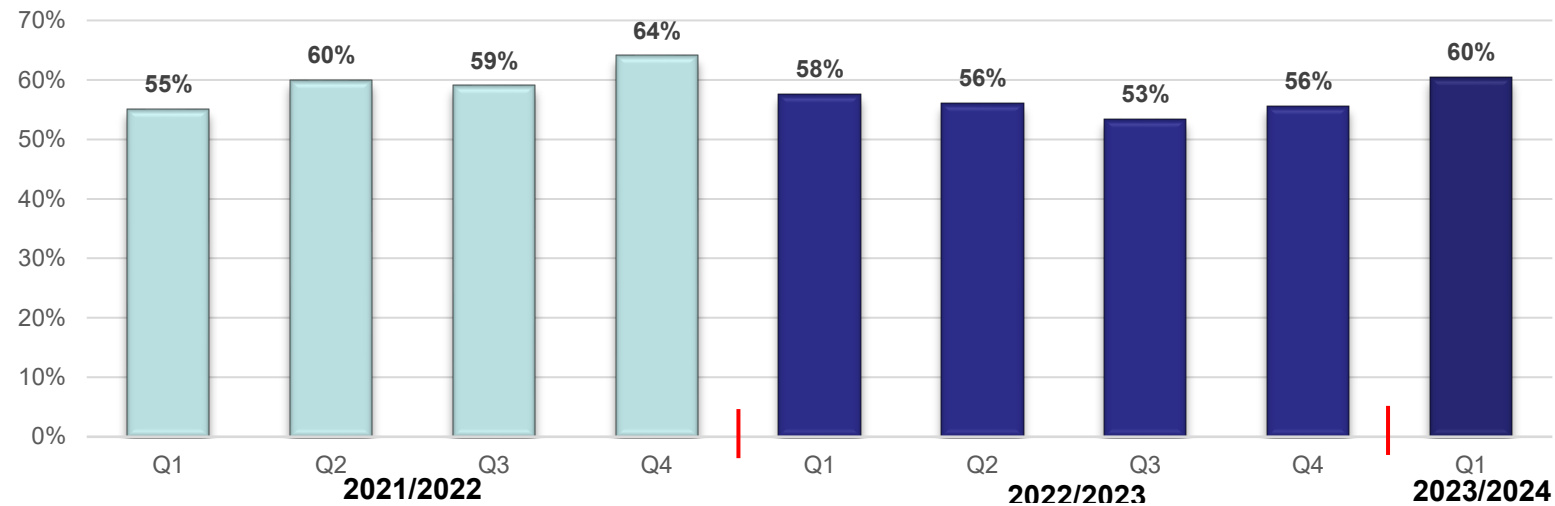

Total Number of Improvement Orders Served



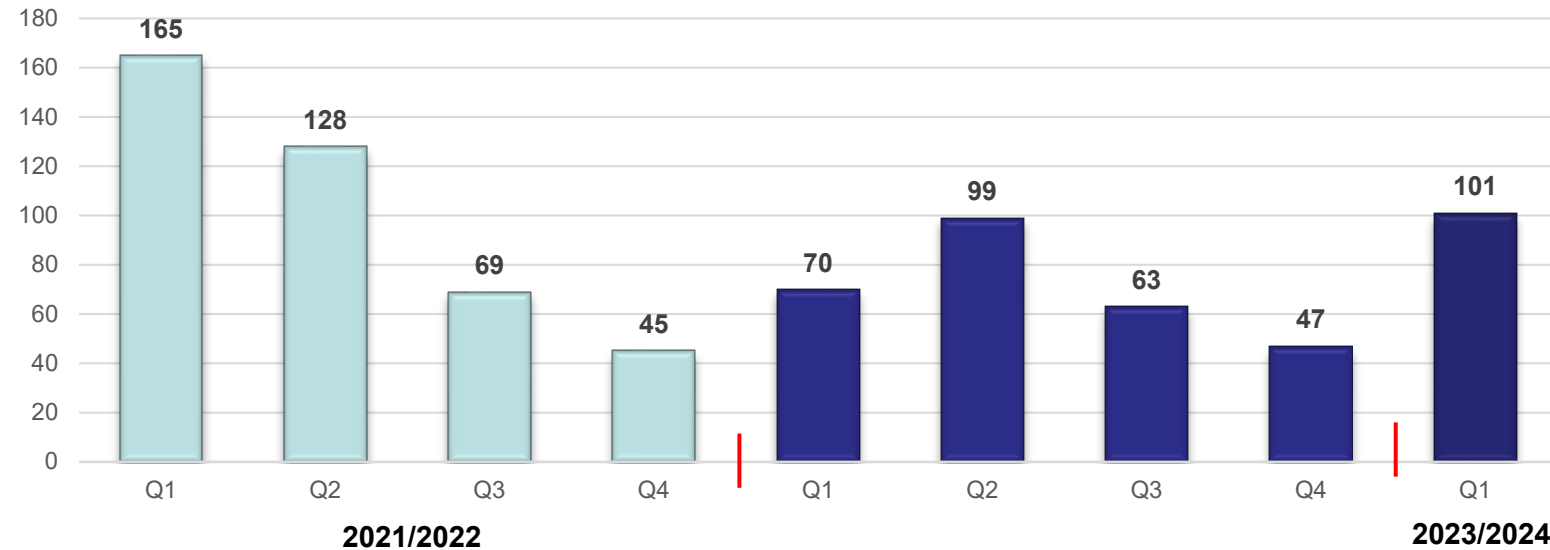
Percentage of Inspections Resulting in Improvement Orders



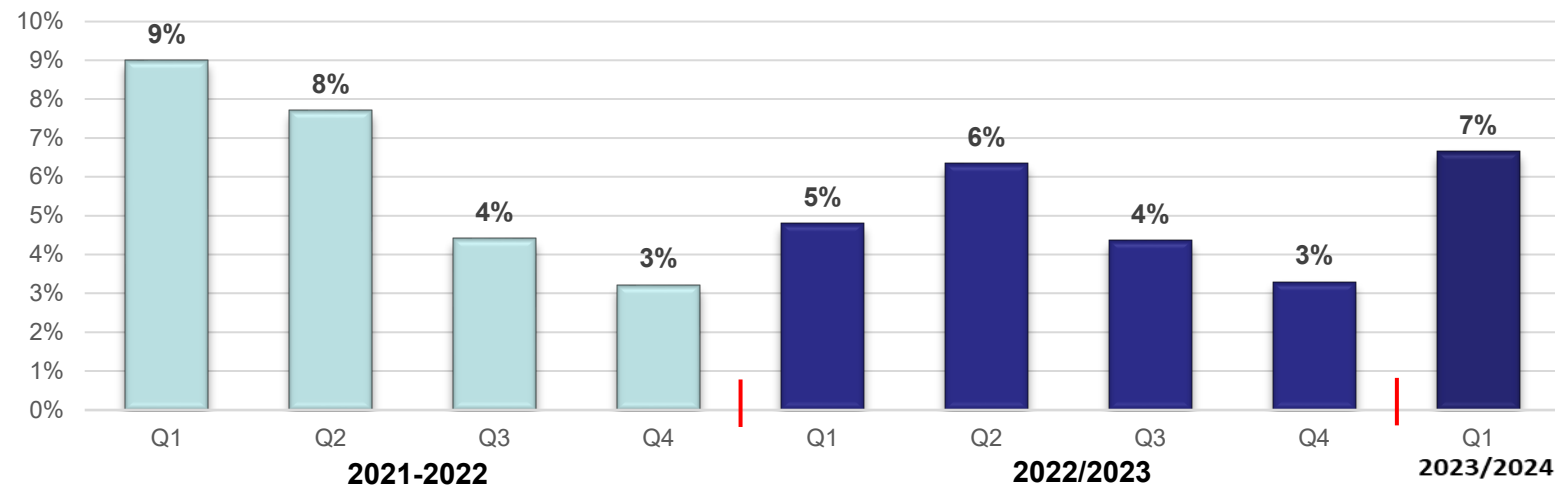

Building Construction Sector Injury Statistics 2023 year to date

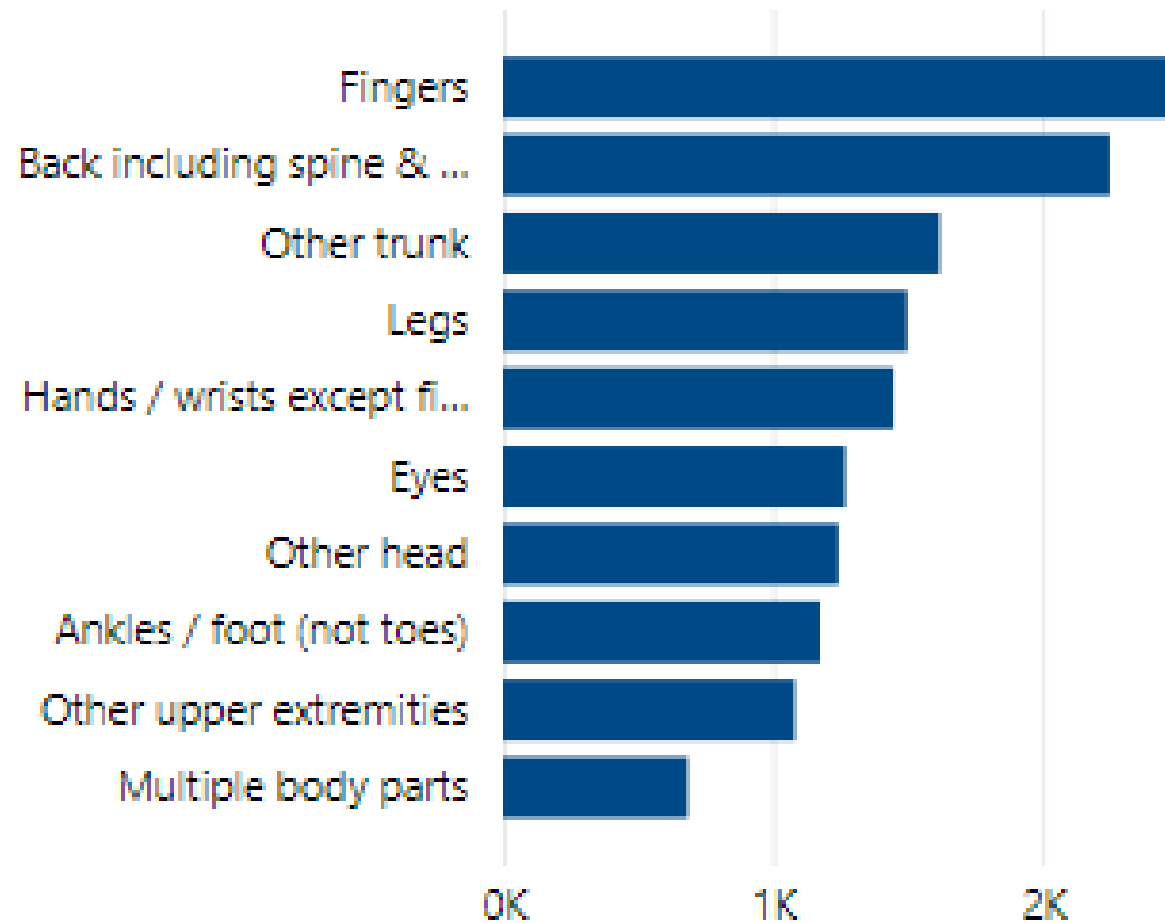

BY INJURY NATURE GROUP

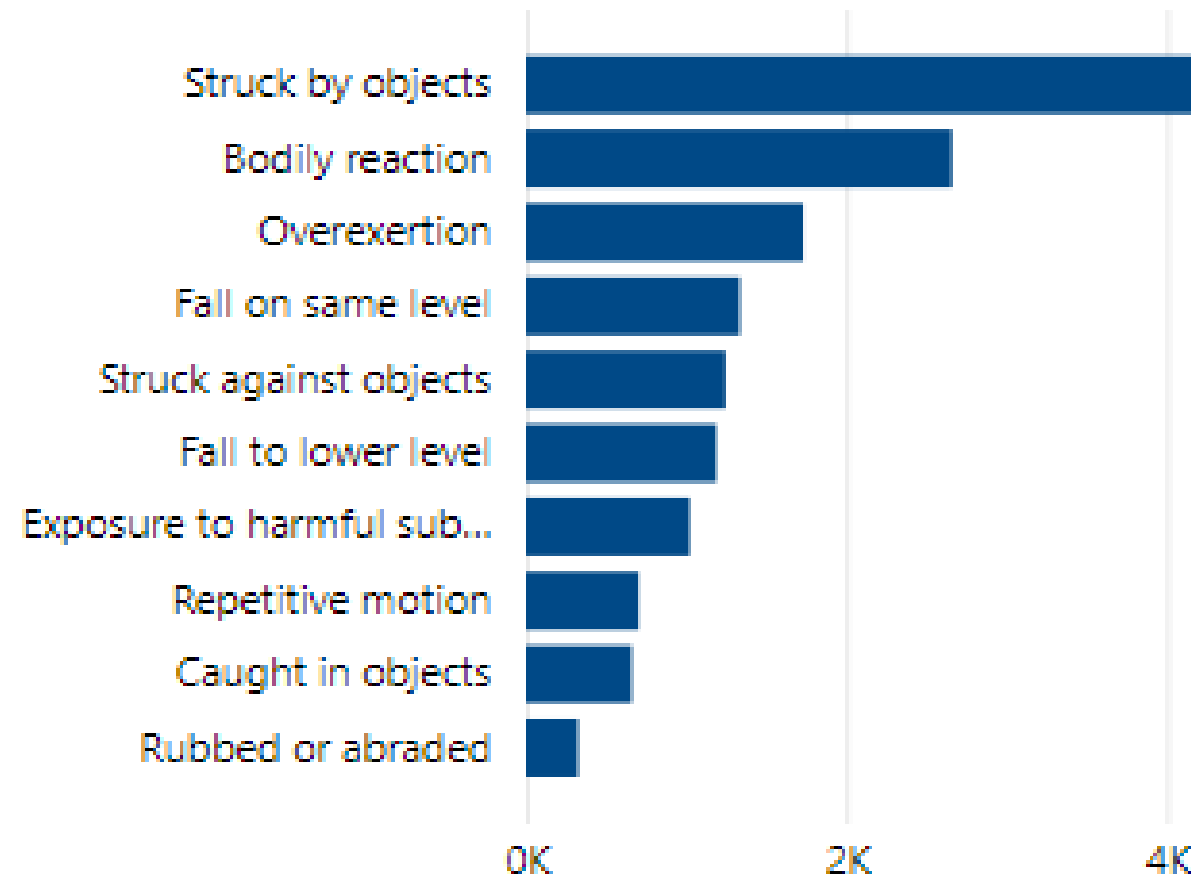


Claims by Body Part Group

Harmonized Audit Instrument

- KEY Changes Include:
 - New Element added: Procurement and Contractor Management
 - Update to Required Training Competencies
- Available in print, our website & via the Online Audit Tool
- Companies to use either audit instrument until **November 1st, 2023**
- *General processes have not changed*



Harmonized Audit Instrument

- KEY Changes Include:
 - New Element added: Procurement and Contractor Management
 - Update to Required Training Competencies
- Available in print, our website & via the Online Audit Tool
- Companies to use either audit instrument until **November 1st, 2023**
- *General processes have not changed*



Audit Submission Methods

- Recertification Years
 - Supporting documentation is still required
 - The company must pass an internal audit by CSAM and an independent audit
- Maintenance Years (years 2, 3, 5, 6, etc.)
 - Supporting documentation is no longer required if the audit is completed by a **Registered Auditor**
 - CSAM will still visit a minimum of 1 jobsite
 - If inconsistencies, CSAM may require a full audit
- Submission Method: Paper OR Online Audit Tool

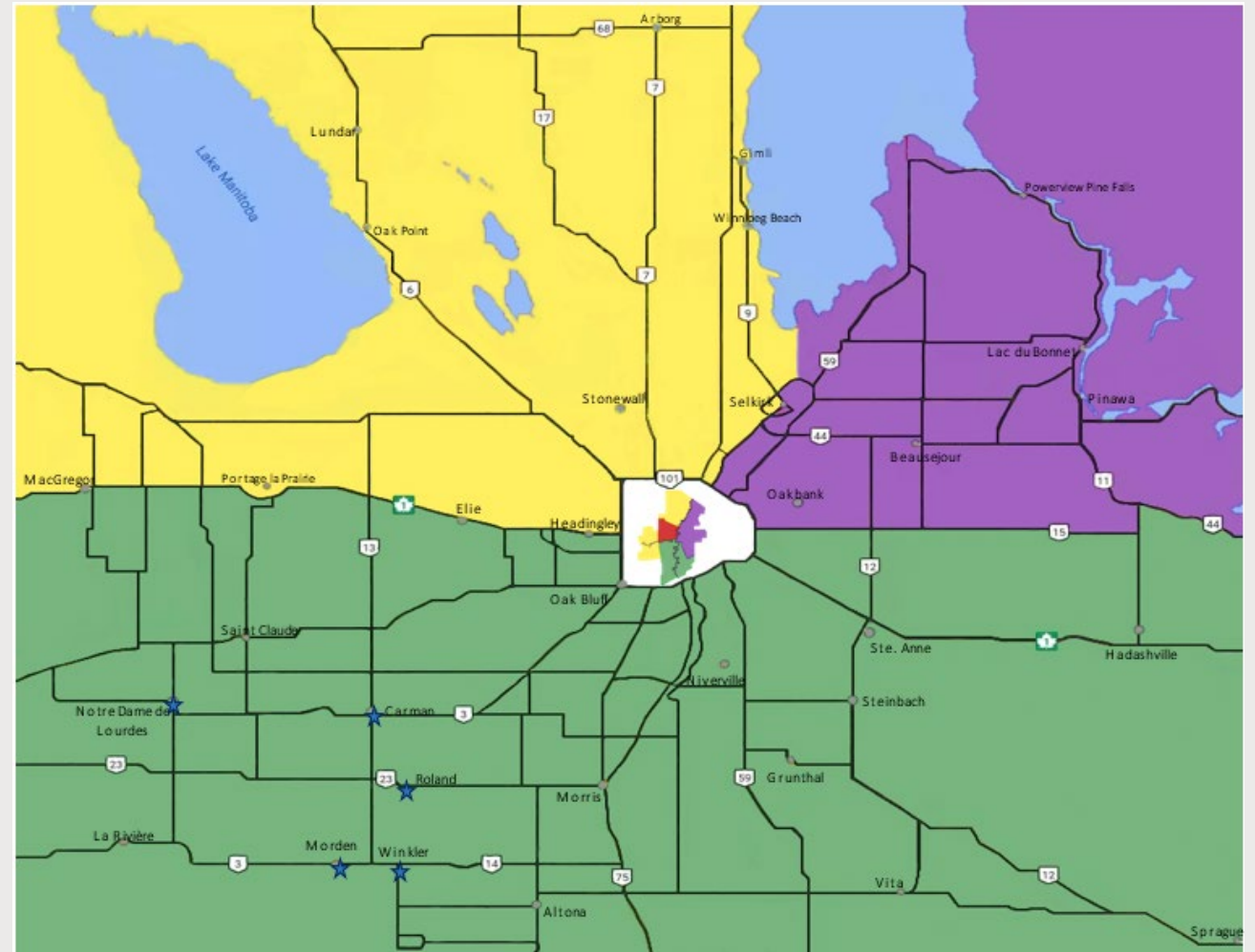
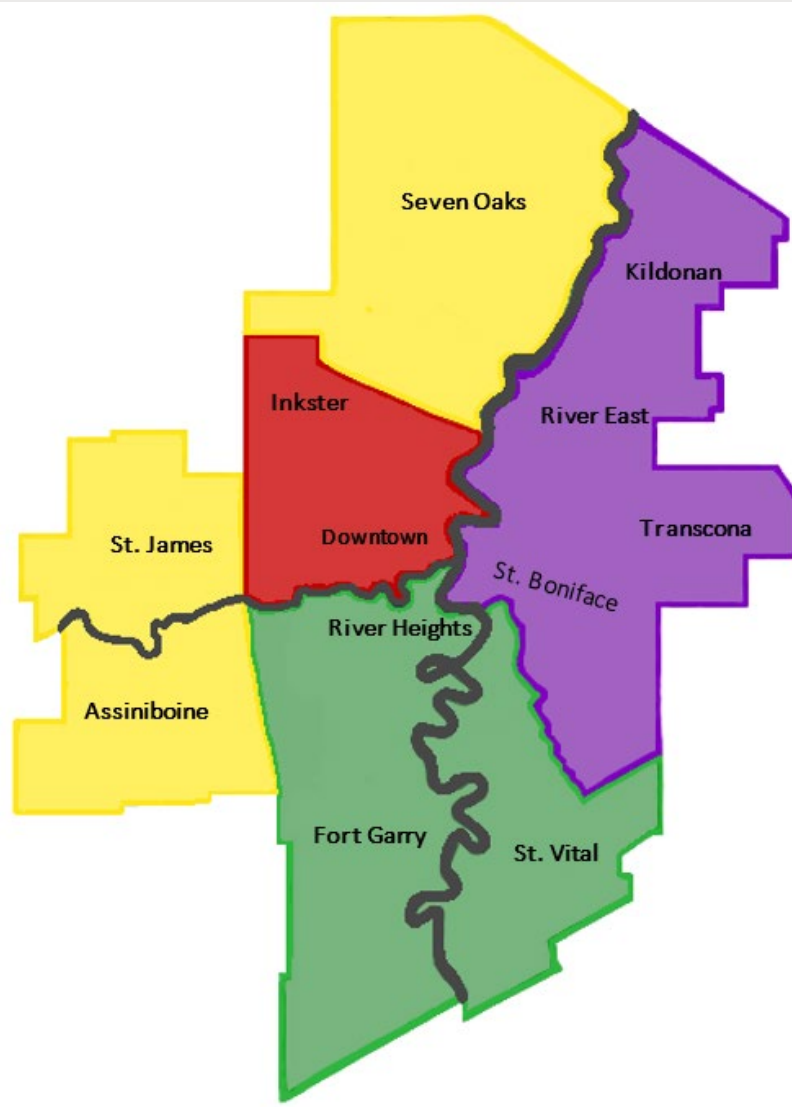


CSAM Staffing Changes
