### **40103 FLOORING AND TILING**

This classification is the 10th largest of the (17) levied Classifications assigned to CSAM. Its 2022 Actual Payroll dropped slightly from 2021 and is currently \$40.7M. Approximately 31% of this payroll is safety certified.

There were a total of (5) Severe Injuries within the classification in 2022 down from (8) from the year before. Four of the injuries took place in a non-certified work environment. Employers within this group paid approximately \$606.4k in premium and certified employers enjoyed a rebate of approximately \$36.3k.

This classification is currently in the 150% Risk Category however recent claims cost analysis suggests costs are more reflective of the 200% Risk Category.
