Painting and Decorating Classification 40105 saw virtually no payroll growth in 2022. Actual Payroll was reported as \$58.9M making it the 9th largest levied classification assigned to CSAM.

Severe Injuries were up substantially in 2022, = (16) compared to (6) the year before. (7) of the (16) took place in a safety certified work environment. Of the other (9), the injuries were the responsibility of non certified Small Employers (Payroll less than <\$750,000). Approximately 40% of the payroll is certified.

Painting and Decorating continues to incur claims costs in the 200% Risk Category.
