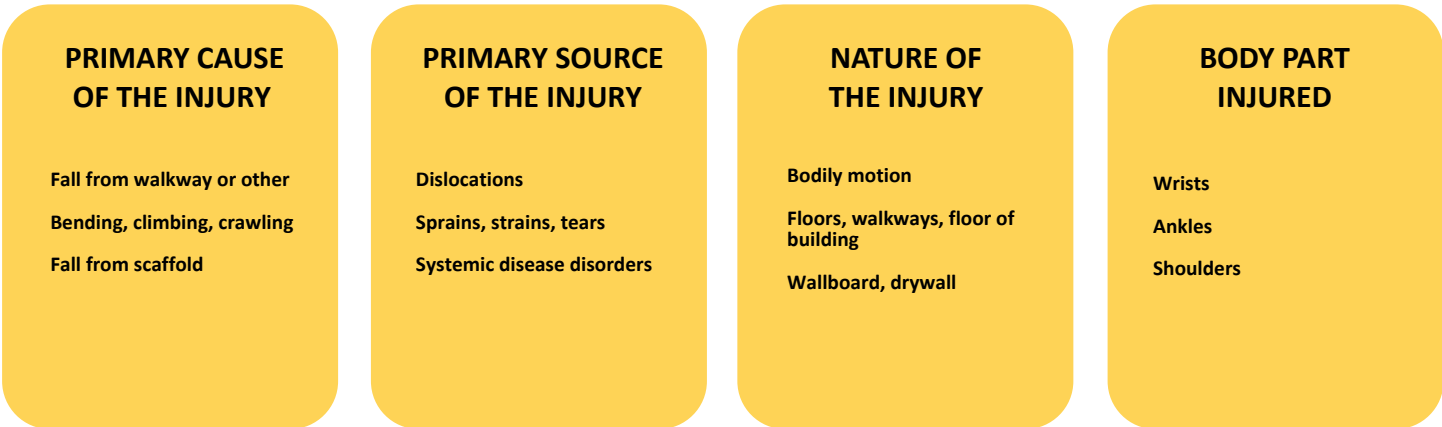
TIMELOSS INJURIES

40108 DRYWALL AND STUCCO CONTRACTING

This classification's Actual Payroll remained relatively flat in 2022, reported at \$68.5M. This amount represents about 4% of all levied payroll assigned to CSAM. It is the 6th largest Classification of the 18 levied classifications. About 50% of this payroll is safety certified.

Severe Injuries (16) are down (1) from the previous year. (9) of these incidents took place in a safety certified work environment. This Classification paid \$2.2M in premium of which \$169k was returned to safety certified companies by rebate. The classification continues a trend of incurring claims costs in the 300% Risk Category.

Please refer to the cover page to identify the top (3) drivers of Severe Injuries. Our primary attention is given to Severe Injuries as they account for approximately 80% of claims costs.
