This classification saw an Actual Payroll increase of 3% (\$61.8M) in comparison to 2021. Approximately 50% of this reported payroll is safety certified.

There was a total of 14 Severe Injuries in 2022, of which 5 took place in a safety certified work environment. There was a dramatic decrease in Time Loss Injuries from 70 in 2021, to 43 in 2022.

This classification pays rates based on the 300% Risk Category, however, over the past number of years claims costs have been tracking in the 250% Risk Category. If this trend continues the majority of employers will see a rate decrease in the immediate future.
