40115 LANDSCAPING

This classification continues to show significant growth year over year now reporting Actual Payroll of \$72.7M up 13% from the previous year. Approximately 26% of this payroll is safety certified.

Severe Injuries dropped to (16) from (20) the previous year of which (10) took place in a non-certified work environment.

This classification was recently allocated to the 150% Risk Category due to high claims costs. High claims costs have continued and the classification will be placed in the 200% Risk Category for 2024 Rate calculations. The vast majority of the approximate 400 employers will see a rate increase as a result. The classification continues to be monitored to determine whether further increases are warranted.
