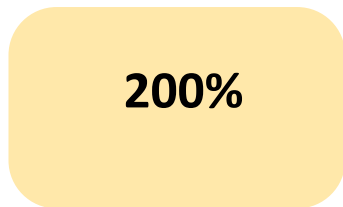
## SEVERE INJURIES



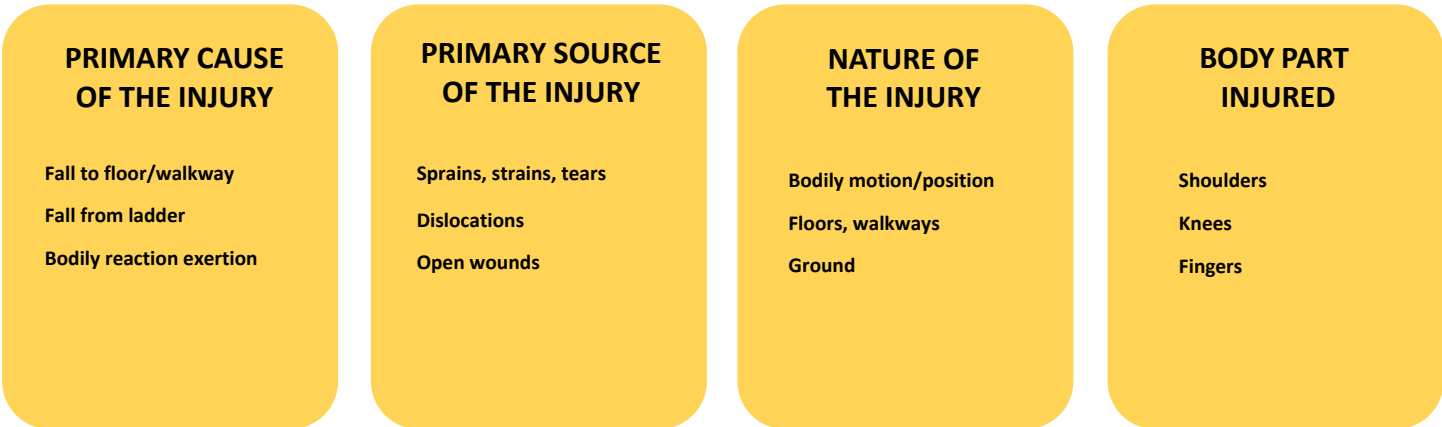
## TIMELOSS INJURIES

## 40204 PLUMBING, INSULATING & MECHANICAL

This classification remains the (2nd) largest of the levied classifications despite an approximate 10% drop in Actual Payroll. 2022 Actual Payroll has been reported as \$416.4M. This payroll represents approximately 21% of levied payroll assigned to CSAM and is responsible for 17% of Severe Injuries.

Severe Injuries were down from the previous year 2021=59, to 2022=52. (32) of these injuries took place in a Medium sized employer environment (\$750,000>\$7.5M). (27) of these employers were safety certified. 20 of the Severe Injuries occurred in a small employer environment (<\$750,000) of which 6 were safety certified.

Approximately 68% of this payroll is safety certified. Employers within the classification continue to incur claims costs consistent with the 200% Risk Category.
