This classification saw another significant Actual Payroll increase of 9% when comparing 2021 to 2022, and now stands at \$289M. This is a non-levied classification that is approximately 36% safety certified.

In 2022, the classification did not have a Severe Injury and had a total of (9) Time Loss Injuries. It currently resides in the lowest Risk Category available at 15%.

Given its low volume of claims, the (5) year history is specific to Time Loss Injuries rather than Severe Injuries.
