In 2023, Painting & Decorating saw an increase in Actual Payroll from \$58.9M to \$62.7 or 6%. Approximately 33% of this payroll is safety certified.

Severe Injuries returned closer to the norm at (8) during 2023, a significant drop from the (16) the previous year. Time Loss Injuries also dropped from (38) to (34). Positive signs given the payroll growth would suggest an increase in overall exposure hours.

This classification continues to incur claims costs within the 200% Risk Category.
