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This classification saw significant payroll growth in 2023 from \$61.8M in 2022 to \$71.2M in 2023 or 15% growth. Approximately 47% of this payroll is safety certified.

Severe Injuries also increased from (14) in 2022 to (19) in 2023. Time Loss Injuries also increased from (43) to (65).

This classification had seen some improvement of claims costs over the years, with the possibility of dropping a Risk Category, however, most recently has shown costs more reflective of the 300% Risk Category where it will remain.
